History

Founded in 1881, **Canadian Pacific Railway** was formed to unite Canada from coast to coast and grew to reach the U.S. Midwest and beyond with direct links to major ports on the west and east coasts.



Established in 1887, **Kansas City Southern** began as a belt railroad in Kansas City, Mo and grew to become a vital north-south rail link providing customers with cross-border service between the U.S. and Mexico.

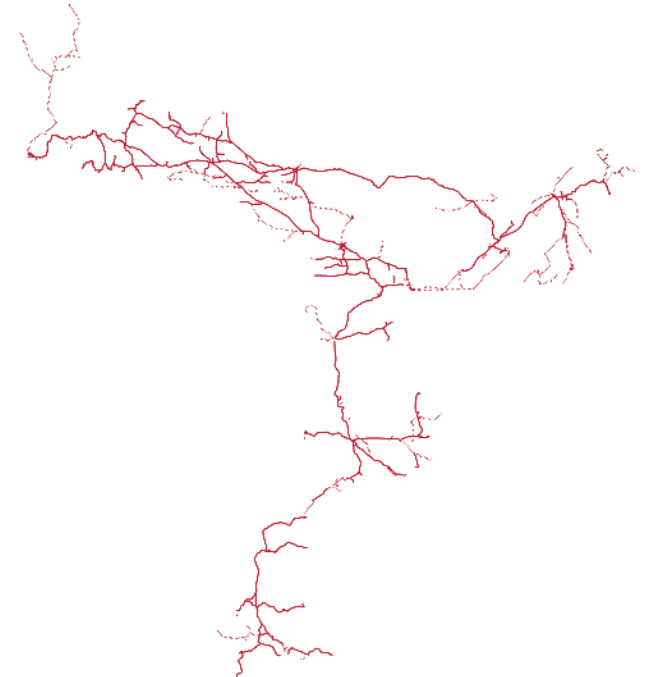

In 2023, **CPKC** made history by creating the first and only transnational railway that connects Canada, the U.S. and Mexico with unrivaled cross-border services and port access. CPKC unlocks the full potential of the CP and KCS networks and our people to connect markets and communities far and wide, while fostering growth and economic prosperity across North America.





CPKC Post Merger

- CPKC is improving service with laser scans of bridges, tunnels and other obstructions to enhance safety, efficiency and reduce customer wait times.
 - 2025 Q1/Q2 – Southern United States territory (south of Kansas City) in progress
 - 2025 Q4 – Mexico territory to initiate/be started
- Modernizing Internal programs:
 - CPKC Monterrey Clearance Office will use an aligned Dimensional Application program to manage and safeguard shipments travelling from Laredo, TX to Kansas City, MO.



Dimensional Offices and Territory Covered

1. Calgary, AB protects all load & proposal requests originating in:
 - Canada
 - US Northern region to Kansas City MO.
2. Monterrey, NL protects all load & proposal requests originating in:
 - Mexico
 - US Southern region from Kansas City MO.
